

Progress Update

June 2024

As we continue to progress with the project, we wanted to issue an update prior to the summer holiday period.

As works have been completed to one of the permanent car parks, you will see we have now moved into our larger, main welfare cabins on Footfield Road. This utilises the completed car park for some contractor parking to keep the streets as clear as we can.

As the foundations are complete and the steel frame is nearing completion, attention is now turning to the roof and the preparation works for the ground floor. During the upcoming school summer holidays, to minimise any impact, we have sequenced footpath works to Babylon Road and minor road works to Footfield Road.

We would like to take this opportunity to share some of the positive outcomes that have been achieved from the development so far:

- Employment of 3 local people
- 3 local apprentices employed on site
- 2 young people given invaluable work experience
- Learning sessions with pupils giving an insight into the construction activities
- 1,319 less lorry journeys through Orbiston by retaining excavated material within the development.
- 66.5 tonnes of carbon saved (the equivalent of heating 25 homes for a year) through greener choices
