WELCOME to the July Millcroft Road Newsletter, updating owner occupiers, residents and landlords on the progress being made with the Millcroft Road Regeneration Project.

Compulsory Purchase Order – Progress Update

The CPO was submitted to the Scottish Government on 29th March 2023 for determination.

The Scottish Government received objections to the CPO and as such, a Scottish Government Hearing was held on the 17th and 18th of April 2024 at the Castlecary Hotel, Castlecary Road, Cumbernauld, G68 0HD. The Hearing was adjourned by the Scottish Government Reporter and two further dates were added to the Scottish Government Hearing process, the 4th and 6th of June 2024 at the DPEA Offices, Hadrian House, Callendar Business Park, Falkirk.

Since the Scottish Government Hearing was not concluded at this time, the Hearing will again reconvene upon the Reporter's request on Tuesday 27th August 2024 at the Castlecary Hotel, Castlecary Road, Castlecary, Glasgow, G68 0HD, at 11:30 AM.

The Hearing is a public process and any affected parties are welcome to attend. We will continue to keep all parties informed as the Scottish Government Hearing process comes to conclusion.

Following the Hearing the Scottish Government Reporter will submit a recommendation to the relevant Scottish Government Ministers who will determine the outcome of the CPO. All owners and residents will be kept updated throughout this process via North Lanarkshire Council.

Owners and tenants of private landlords

In August 2022 Council Committee approval was granted for further voluntary acquisitions to proceed in the event of the CPO being confirmed. This means that if the CPO is confirmed by the Scottish Government, then it is proposed that the Council will consider further voluntary acquisitions ahead of the General Vesting Date (the point at which the Council acquire all property interests via the CPO legislation).

The purpose of this is to assist with re-housing remaining owner occupiers and tenants as soon as possible.

The North Lanarkshire Common Housing Register (CHR) is a partnership between North Lanarkshire Council and partner Registered Social Landlords (Housing Associations and Co-operatives) who have social rented housing stock in the North Lanarkshire area. Through a single, shared application form, applicants are placed on a common register which all partner landlords can access - simplifying and maximising access to housing.

What happens next?

All owners and residents will be kept updated regarding the timescales for the CPO process, but it is anticipated that it will take anything up to 18 months for the CPO to be determined, from the date the 1st Notice was served.

The council are continuing to contact individual residents directly to assess rehousing options and next steps. Continuous updates on each stage of the process will be communicated to all residents and owners
