This follows on from recent major investment in Motherwell Rail Station and Muir Street where the council worked with SPT, Transport Scotland and Network Rail through our Glasgow City Region City Deal project to improve public transport facilities.

With funding support from SPT, the Scottish Government's Place Based Investment Programme and the UK Government's Shared Prosperity Fund, we have carried out design work and are undertaking work on West Hamilton Street this year to improve crossings arrangements for pedestrians and cyclists; widen footways to enable shared use for walking, wheeling and cycling and repair bus laybys.

The work will start on 15th July and is expected to finish early October.
