UKSPF Challenge Fund

North Lanarkshire's Employability Partnership aims to fund a number of short term and **innovative** all age employability projects across our communities. These will be **in addition** to the existing range of employability projects currently being delivered this year. The partnership is seeking projects which can **engage unemployed or economically inactive** residents of working age and support them in their journey to employment, training or further education.

Budget for all age provision - £300,000

Indicative maximum amount per project - £65,000
