## **Privacy Notice**

The Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (Scotland) Regulations 2021 places a duty on licensing authorities to publish, on their websites, a register of those licensed: to sell animals as pets, operate an animal welfare establishment, rehome animals or breed puppies, kits (baby rabbits) and/or kittens. The register must include the following information:

- the name of the licence holder,
- the licence number,
- the postcodes of—
  - (i) those selling animals as pets, operating an animal welfare establishment, breeding 3 or more litters of puppies in a 12 month period, breeding 3 or more litters of kittens (cat under 12 months) in any 12 month period, breeding 6 or more litters of kits (rabbits aged less than 3 months) in a 12 month period, the premises specified in the licence;
  - (ii) in the case of a licence for the licensable activity described in paragraph 4 of schedule 1 (engaging in animal rehoming activities), the postcode of any premises in Scotland from which the activity is carried on (if known);
- the date on which the licence was granted,
- if the licence has been renewed, the date on which it was renewed,
- the date on which the licence is due to expire,
- the type of animals that may be sold (for those licensed to sell pets),
- information as to whether the licence is suspended.

If your application is granted, as a relevant licence holder, your licence information will be included in the published register. The register will be published on the North Lanarkshire Council website. For further information on how we process your information please see our privacy policy:
